






The design of the garden is influenced by the surrounding bushland corridor, the flowing Yarra River, and local engagements with the walking bicycle paths that weave through the landscape.














COUNTRY ESTATE


Gravel pathways leading to secluded leafy clearings, romance and clipped hedges amongst a variety of loose plantings are all hallmarks of Country landscape design. Add to the space, pergolas draped with wisteria, walls covered in climbing vines and mature trees growing wild amidst ornamental grasses. Working with the Australian climate and landscape is an integral element of making country garden landscape design work within the parameters of the existing architecture. The key to the success of Country Garden Design, is utilising a planting palette of resilient trees and shrubs that stand up to the harsh elements. Where possible capturing an embracing the surrounding borrowed landscape will always help to ground this style of garden within its environment.

















ESTATE GARDEN

Formal or classical landscape design requires a well-proportioned structure of geometrically balanced elements throughout. This is often achieved by creating a main access line, and several secondary lines. Then adopting several other design tools, such as: Staggered and varied planting heights to create depth, repetitive and symmetrical planting layouts, and the placement of ornamentation such as large urns, sculptures, etc that will create focal points to draw and rest the eye.

Water is always a welcome softening element within these gardens with its movement and cool refreshing sound.

We believe the secret to creating a well-executed formal garden is getting the scale right and being prepared to use a **bold** hand in the selection of plants and ornamentation, which all contribute to finishing a garden with an overall sense of sophistication.







We care about the finer details of pool design including tile selction, water quality, lighting, filtration and the correct planting pallet which are all paramount to a successful pool design.















